### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

From fabrics below, cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" WOF strips. Subcut each into (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



From fabrics below, cut (2) 3½" x 21" WOF strips. Subcut each into (6) 3½" x 6½" rectangles.



From fabrics below, cut (4) 3½" x 21" WOF strips. Subcut each into (10) 3½" x 6½" rectangles.




#### PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

The Garden Moon quilt is made up of 11 rows of 20 vertical rectangles each.

First, organize your rectangles following the diagram to the right.



Sew the rectangles in pairs, Right Side Together (RST). Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.



Finally, sew the rows together. Nest the seams for easy alignment. Press seams open to minimize bulk.

Press quilt top for a nice finish. Baste, quilt, and bind as desired.
